What is Divine Mercy?

- Divine Mercy is God's love and compassion for all people, especially those who are struggling or have sinned. Romans 3:23 – “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”
- Divine Mercy is a message of hope that reminds us that God is always ready to forgive us and welcome us back into His loving embrace.
- Divine Mercy is a gift from God that we can receive by asking for forgiveness, showing kindness to others, and trusting in His love and mercy.



St. Faustina

- Born in Poland in 1905
- Felt called to be a nun at 7
- In her teens, she wanted to join a convent but her parents did not let her
- At 20, she finally was able to become a nun
- Jesus began to appear to her and tell her messages that she would write down in her diary
- Jesus asked her to paint an image of a vision she saw of Him, with "Jesus, I Trust in You: written below

"Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God. All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy." (No. 301)
