### Step 1: The Image

### Step 2: A Friendship with Jesus



Jesus told St. Faustina: Talk to me simply, as a friend to a friend.

Jesus also said: Tell Me all My child, hide nothing from Me, because My loving Heart, the Heart of your Best Friend, is listening to you."

Spend time praying to Jesus and speaking to him as a friend. He is your very best friend and is there for you always!

# Step 3: "Behold your Mother"

You can get closer to Jesus through Mary, His mother!




#### Jesus said Behold, your mother (John 19:27), giving Mary to the church
